During summer, set it to increase the temperature a few degrees, and then during winter, have it lower the temperature a few degrees.

Seal air leaks and add insulation – You can save up to 10% on your annual energy bills by sealing air leaks and adding insulation. Applying caulk around windows and weather stripping around doors is inexpensive and effective.
